

**Rostered Players /Coaches Residing in Out of State (i.e. New Jersey)**  
*Out of State Players other than NJ should follow similar procedure for their state.*

1. Obtain a player / coach pass from the New Jersey State Youth Soccer Association. *Please contact the NJ State office for the details on what they require to issue a pass, see contact info provided.*
2. Obtain, fill out and sign a NJ Permission to Play Out of State Form for players, available from the NJ State Youth Soccer Association (similar to a Pennsylvania PS 1).
3. Submit the player's completed NJ paperwork to the EPYSA office.
4. Upon receiving the stamped paperwork from EPYSA or confirmation that the player is now available in the current years database - submit this paperwork along with the registration items as per LVYSL requirements.
5. Coaches, *who need a pass for themselves or other assistant coaches*, need only do items #1 and 2. Submit those items along with a photocopy of his/her coaching license in the registration packet a per LVYSL requirements.
6. NOTE: New Jersey now allows players to play as secondary to teams out of state.

PLEASE REMEMBER THAT BECAUSE ITEMS MUST BE PROCESSED BY NJSYSA AND EPYSA  
THEN RETURNED TO LVYSL
